We hope this letter finds you well.

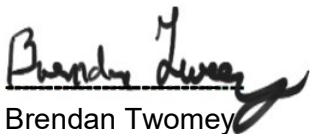
A notice to submit a planning application for the proposed Cummeennabuddoge Wind Farm has been placed in The Corkman, The Kerryman and the Irish Examiner newspapers this week. You will also see planning notices being erected and displayed around the project site for this FuturEnergy Ireland and SSE Renewables co-development. The application is expected to be submitted by Cummeennabuddoge Wind Designated Activity Company (DAC) to An Bord Pleanála shortly.

When An Bord Pleanála has received and validated the planning application, the full suite of planning application documentation, including the Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR), will be uploaded and available to view at www.cummeennabuddogeplanning.ie and at www.pleanala.ie. A hard copy of the planning application and EIAR will also be available at the offices of An Bord Pleanála, Cork County Council and Kerry County Council.

There is a useful FAQ section on An Bord Pleanála's website that provides guidance on public participation. Any person or body may make observations on the project to An Bord Pleanála after the application has been submitted. The time frame to make an observation is seven weeks. To give you an indication of the planning decision timeline, on average it is taking 12 to 18 months for a decision to be made on wind energy projects.

I will keep you informed on progress as it is happening and any other news.

Tá súil agam go bhfuil tú go maith.

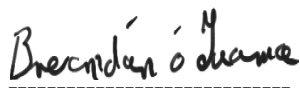
Tá fógra chun iarratas pleanála a chur isteach don Fheirm Ghaoithe atá beartaithe i Choimín na Bodóige curtha sna nuachtáin Corkman, Kerryman agus an Irish Examiner an tseachtain seo. Feicfidh tú chomh maith, fógraí pleanála á gcur suas agus le feiscint timpeall shuíomh an tionscadail don chomhfhorbairt seo idir FuturEnergy Ireland agus SSE Renewables. Táthar ag súil go mbeidh an t-iarratas curtha isteach ag 'Cummeennabuddoge Wind Designated Activity Company (DAC)' go dtí an Bord Pleanála go gairid.

Nuair a bheidh an t-iarratas pleanála faighte agus bailíochtaithe ag an mBord Pleanála, déanfar cáipéisí uile an iarratais phleanála, lena n-áirítear an Tuarascáil ar Mheasúnú Tionchair Timpeallachta (TMTT), a uaslódáil agus beidh ar fáil le feiceáil ag cách ar www.cummeennabuddogeplanning.ie agus ag www.pleanala.ie. Beidh cóip chrua den iarratas pleanála agus an TMTT ar fáil chomh maith in oifigí an Bhoird Phleanála agus in oifigí Chomhairle Contae Chorcaí agus in oifigí Chomhairle Contae Chiarraí.

Tá rannán úsáideach Ceisteanna Coitianta ar shuíomh gréasáin an Bhoird Phleanála a thugann treoir ar rannpháirtíocht an phobail. Is féidir le haon duine nó comhlacht tuairimí a thabhairt don Bhord Pleanála tar éis don iarratas a bheith curtha isteach. Is é an fráma ama chun tuairimí a thabhairt seacht seachtaine. Le léiriú a thabhairt duit ar amlíne an chinnidh phleanála, ar an meán tógann sé 12 go 18 mí chun cinneadh a dhéanamh ar thionscadail fuinnimh gaoithe.

Coimeádfaidh mé are olas thú maidir le haon dul chun cinn mar a tharlíonn sé agus ar aon nuacht eile.
